

# Household Waste

\*I put my household waste in the bin, in a tightly closed dustbin bag.

## Household waste includes...



## Watch Out...

- Bins are put out for morning collection after 19h00 and are brought straight back inside.
- Batteries are not to be put into the household waste. These can be left at the town hall, local French schools or the British School.

The mobile app « Boucle\_Tri » sends notifications to tell you when to put out your different bins. One can also collect a collection schedule from the town hall.

# Encombrants

\*I put my old furniture on the pavement outside of my house or leave it at the déchetterie or Emmaus

## Encombrants include...

- Old furniture
- Mattresses
- Bicycle Parts
- Rubbish from the attic and cellar



## Watch Out...

- Do not put out any chemical or toxic products.
- Your encombrant limit is 3m2 and cannot weigh more than 50kg
- Check which Saturday of the month you are allowed to put encombrants out as it is different in each area. You can ask the neighbors.

# Plastic & Cartons

\*This does not include cream & yoghurt pots, plastic bags or dirty, greasy card.

- I put my loose recycling waste in the yellow-lidded bin.



### Paper...

- Newspapers, and magazines without plastic wrappings



### Metal packaging...

- Tins & cans
- Aerosols
- Aluminum tubs



### Cardboard...

- Cereal boxes
- Small/Medium size packing boxes



### Plastic bottles...

- Including milk bottles & liquid soap bottles

# Glass

\*I put my loose glass bottles and jars in the green-lidded bin.

### Watch Out...This does not include...

- Metal jar lids or bottle corks
- Window panes and mirrors
- Light-bulbs
- Broken dishes or pottery glassware



# Chemical & Toxic Waste

\*I put my chemical and toxic waste in the collection van

- The collection van will be in the Carrefour car park from 8h30 until 12h30 on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of each month.

### This includes...

- Solvents & cleaning products
- Paint
- Ink cartridges
- Light bulbs, LED and Neon lights
- Car batteries



# Bio-Degradable

\*I put my bio-degradable waste in the brown bin or in unsealed bags

- I can put out either 7 sacks or 4 sacks and the bin.

### Do not include...

- Tree roots or branches\*
- Earth or soil
- Flower pots
- Pesticides
- Plastics



\*Branches with a diameter of no more than 10 cms and length of 1.2 meters can be tied in bundles and put outside.
